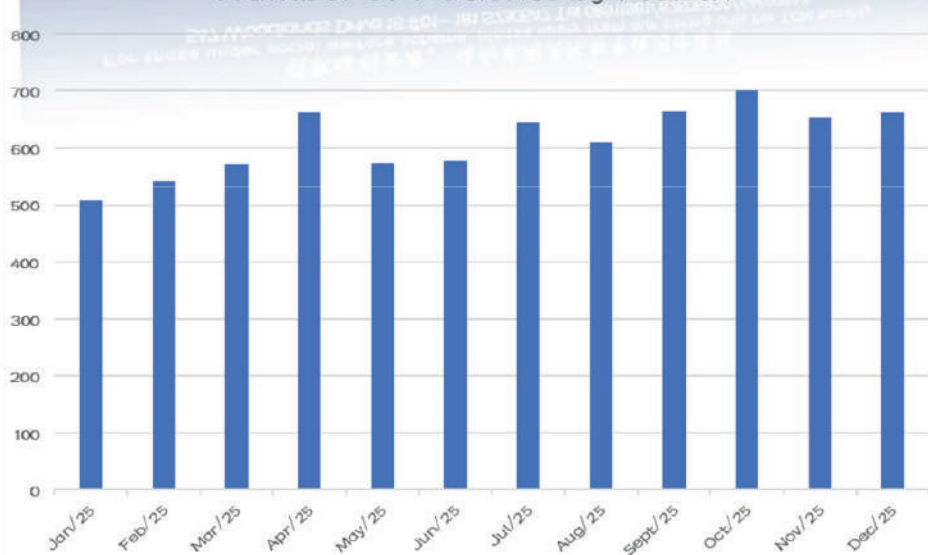

Workplace learning capabilities building project
by Republic Polytechnic (RP)

Republic Polytechnic and Republic Polytechnic Academy for Continuing Education – RP AGE

“More people need to know about the good work that Realm of Tranquility does.” This was the shared goal that emerged when Realm of Tranquility partnered with the National Centre of Excellence for Workplace Learning @ Republic Polytechnic (NACE@RP) earlier this year under the NACE Mentorship Support Grant (MSG) Workplace Learning Capability Building Project: To develop In-house Capabilities to engage in Multichannel Online Marketing. Realm of Tranquility is a nonprofit organisation dedicated to promoting social responsibility by encouraging mutual assistance and spreading warmth and compassion throughout the Admiralty community. Like many charities, they face challenges with volunteer recruitment and fundraising through digital platforms. To address this, the organisation saw an opportunity to upskill their team in content creation — and the RP team stepped in with a practical, learner-centric approach. Three senior lecturers — Ms Leong Phei Phei and Mr Goh Yong Sheng from Republic Polytechnic School of Business – RP SBZ, and Ms Shannon Chan from NACE@RP — designed a six-month workplace learning programme focused on strengthening the charity’s social media capabilities. With the support of students from the Diploma in Mass Communication (DMC), the team trained Realm of Tranquility’s staff to create engaging content across Facebook, Instagram, and even helped launch their TikTok presence. “The consultants from RP used a flexible and adaptive workplace learning approach that went beyond the classroom,” said Ms Chooi May Yin, President of Realm of Tranquility. “They introduced practical activities that allowed our staff to apply what they learnt immediately and continued sharpening their skills through On-the-Job Training (OJT).” Although the NACE-MSG project has concluded, our collaboration continues. Realm of Tranquility is now part of RP’s Design Your Impact programme and has offered internship opportunities to our DMC students in the upcoming semester.

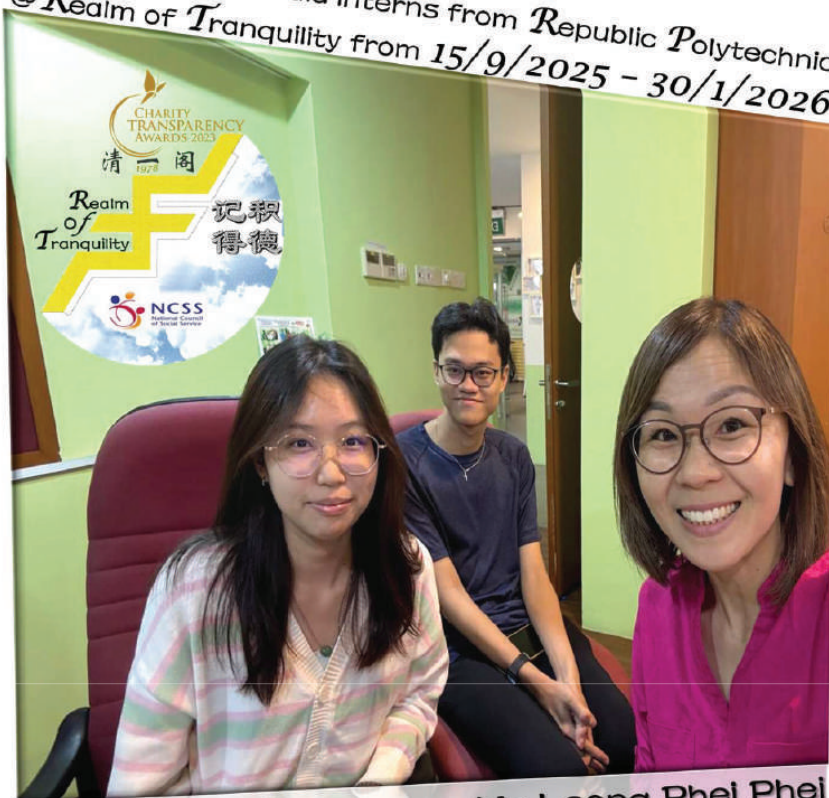

- Review and approve monthly financial statements;
- Regularly monitor the progress of the charity's programmes.

Reserves Policy

The Reserve of Realm provides financial stability and the means for the development of its activities. The Board intends to maintain the reserves at a level sufficient at all times of at least twelve (12) months' value for its operating needs. The Board reviews the level of reserves regularly for Realm's continuing obligations.

Purpose of Restricted Funds

The restricted funds were utilised according to the specific purposes:

– Invictus Fund (Tech-and-GO! Consultancy Fund)
During the financial year ended 31 December 2024, the Society was granted with the Cyber Security & Data Protection Consultancy Fund, this for the purpose to provide one-on-one consultancy service to the Agency to support the Society in completing the Data Protection Essentials programme. The NCSS has agreed the funding amount that may be provided to the Society shall be capped at S\$81,600 or 80% of the actual expenditure of the supported costs, whichever is lower. The funding period is from 2 September 2024 (“Commencement Date”) to 31 December 2028 (“End Date”) (both date inclusive), or such other period as may be agreed in writing between the NCSS and the Society.

– VWOs-Charities Capability Fund
There is a balanced amount of \$8,663 in this fund.

Realm has disclosed its restricted funds in the Financial Statements, Note 13.2 of page 30. Please refer to the Financial Statements for more information.

Conflict of Interest Policy

All Board members and staff are required to comply with the charity's conflict of interest policy.

The Board has put in place documented procedures for Board members and staff to declare annually, actual, or potential conflicts of interests on a regular and need-to basis. Board members also abstain and do not participate in decision-making on matters where they have a conflict of interest. All Board members and staff are required to comply with the charity's conflict of interest policy.

Procurement Contracts

Procurement of goods and services is on an arm's length basis. The organisation does not procure any service from a Board member or his/her relative on less attractive terms than could have been obtained from the open market.

Office Bearers

The office bearers of the Board do not hold more than one post as Office Bearers in the Board.

Finance & Funding

Realm of Tranquility is self-funded. It organizes fund raising events and receives donations from corporations, volunteers, members, and supporters.

There is segregation of duties for the one who receives the donations money, banks in money and does the accounts. All payments are made via bank transfer prepared by the Hon Treasurer/employed accounting staff and approved by the President, with supporting invoices and bills.

The President and Hon. Treasurer remain the authorized joint signatories for all bank documents in 2025.

The financial year end of Realm of Tranquility is 31st December of the year and the Statement of Accounts are always audited.
